Dear Mr. Larson:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated October 30, 1984 which transmitted changes identified as Revision 16, to the "Monticello Security Plan" under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p).

We have reviewed the submitted changes and have determined that, except for those items identified in the enclosures, they are consistent with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p) and do not decrease the effectiveness of the plant. These changes are, therefore, acceptable.

For those items identified as being unacceptable under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p), the previously approved plan revisions must be followed. Should you want to pursue changing the plans under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p), you must resubmit changes modified to address our comments. In those instances where you desire to pursue the changes without modification, they must be resubmitted under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.90.

The reporting and/or recordkeeping requirements contained in this letter affect fewer than ten respondents; therefore, OMB clearance is not required under P.L. 95-511.

The enclosures to your letter contain Safeguards Information of a type specified in 10 CFR 73.21 and are being withheld from public disclosure.






