On December 3, 1984 Wisconsin Public Service received a Notice of Violation (Level IV) concerning 10 CFR 50, Appendix J leakage testing during the 1984 refueling outage. On December 21, 1984 WPSC replied to that Notice of Violation (reference 3) and committed to submitting a supplement to Kewaunee's 1984 ILRT report. Enclosed is that supplement which includes an 'as-found' containment leakage rate for the Kewaunee containment at the end of Cycle IX.

In reference 3 WPSC also committed to submit any changes to Proposed Amendment No's. 52, 52A, and 52B necessary to prevent reoccurrence of this noncompliance. Proposed Amendment No. 52C (reference 4) was submitted January 22, 1985 to fulfill this commitment.


