Hi Tom,

Per our call this morning, below is **Section 3.4.1 Remote Site Work** from our Site-Specific Health and Safety Plan, Rio Algom, Ambrosia Lake Mill and Mine Site (INTERA, October 2019), requiring a minimum of two people to perform field work at the Ambrosia Lake Facility.

3.4.1 Remote Site Work

This Site is considered a remote Site. A Site may be considered “remote” if work is being conducted in a location that is isolated from the assistance of other people and/or a highly populated community, road conditions for Site access are poor, and/or there is limited cell phone service. Additionally, work may be considered remote if emergency services cannot reach the location without hindrance. This consideration should be based on procedures for responding to a ‘life-threatening worst-case scenario.’ The following may be considered:

- *A hospital is greater than 20 miles or 40 minutes by car travel,*
- *There is limited cell phone service, or*
- *Travel includes driving on a dirt road for more than 5 miles.*

Site Control requirements include site mapping and preparation, work zones, site security, the buddy system, communication systems, and safe work practice. Furthermore, INTERA’s first line of safety regarding remote sites is that employees are not alone to do remote site work. If a buddy system is not feasible, solo work at a remote site will need approval by the Project Manager and the Corporate HSO before the field event.
