Dear Ms. Puntenney:

This letter is sent to formally acknowledge receipt of your petition under 10 CFR 2.206 which you filed on behalf of the Safe Energy Coalition of Detroit, Michigan. I appreciated the opportunity to meet and speak with you at the Fermi-2 site on February 20th, and I hope you found the site tour informative.

Your petition is being handled in accordance with 10 CFR 2.206. As I indicated during the public meeting at Fermi-2, the staff currently believes that several issues, including those discussed in your petition related to discrepancies between as-built hardware and drawings and the sufficiency of the radwaste systems, require at least partial resolution prior to issuance of a low-power operating license. Thus, I anticipate reaching a final decision on your petition in accordance with §2.206 within the next few weeks.

During the public meeting and in your petition, you expressed the desire to examine proprietary information regarding the portable radwaste system provided to Detroit Edison by the NUS Corporation. My staff has been in contact with you on this matter and we believe appropriate arrangements can be worked out to permit you to examine this information under an appropriate protective agreement.

Enclosed for your information is a copy of a notice that will be published in the Federal Register.
