In response to the Board's request, we write to advise the Board that on reflection and after consideration of the number of transcripts involved, LILCO believes that a page limit of 80 pages is adequate for LILCO's additional crankshaft findings, the block findings and the qualified load findings. LILCO understands that this 80 page limit is an overall limit and encompasses both reply findings as well as initial findings. LILCO also understands that this 80 page limit would not include the crankshaft findings already submitted but that these already submitted crankshaft findings would still be considered by the Board in connection with its decision on the diesel generator contentions.
