Gentlemen:

Please find enclosed the renewal of your NRC Material License.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the Region I Material Licensing Section, (215) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note that the sealed plutonium - beryllium neutron sources are now listed by manufacturer and activity. From a February 25, 1985 telephone conversation between Mr. J. Davis of this office and Mr. C. Spangenberg of your staff, it is our understanding that you do not require the maximum 750 grams of plutonium encapsulated as Pu-Be neutron sources requested in your application and that the listing of individual sources is acceptable. If this is not the case, we would be happy to discuss changes with you.

Please be advised that you must conduct your program involving licensed radioactive materials in accordance with the conditions of your NRC license, representations made in your license application, and NRC regulations. In particular, please note the items in the enclosed, "Requirements for Materials Licensees."

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, the NRC expects licensees to pay meticulous attention to detail and to achieve the high standard of compliance which the NRC expects of its licensees.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. A fee may be charged for inspections in accordance with 10 CFR Part 170. Failure to conduct your program safely and in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in prompt and vigorous enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or in case of serious violations, an imposition of a civil penalty or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Actions, 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C.

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We wish you success in operating a safe and effective licensed program.



SUMMARY

- Previous license amendment (07) allowed 337 gram 4235 and 750 gram PuBe.
- Mr Spangenberg stated they only need 5 sources listed in application with having the option for having 2 sources for each of the Monsanto sources (0.52 Ci and 5 Ci)
- This would keep PuBe under 450 grams and no criticality controls would have to be established as per Reg Guide 10.3.
