
Gentlemen:

It is Maine Yankee's understanding that the following actions are necessary to ensure we are ready for closure of the MOV program. These actions were discussed during the MOV inspection exit meeting on March 1, 1996. These actions and those committed to in reference (c) will be complete by December 31, 1996.

- 1) Review the outstanding recommendations from Technical Evaluations, Self Assessment Program and internal memorandums for effect on the MOV Program.
- 2) Update MOV program based on assessment of recommendations from step 1 above.
- 3) Update the MOV Design Bases Technical Evaluations as needed to be consistent with the latest revision of the MOV Program.
- 4) Submit updated summary matrix with final MOV program closure letter to NRC.
