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ATTACHMENT LP&L RESPONSE TO VIOLATION 8438-01

Violation 8438-01

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Failure to Post Form NRC-3, "Notices to Employees"

10 CFR Parts 19.11(c) and (d) and 50.7(e) require that each licensee, permittee, and applicant shall post Form NRC-3, "Notice to Employees," on its premises. Posting must be at locations sufficient to permit employees protected by this section to observe a copy on the way to or from their place of work.

Contrary to the above, the licensee had not posted Form NRC-3 so that workers could observe a copy on the way to or from their place of work. Specifically, Form NRC-3 was not readily observable near avenues of ingress and egress to and from the control room and the offices of chemistry and health physics within the reactor power block.

Response to Violation

Corrective Steps Taken and Results Achieved

Form NRC-3 has been relocated to a more conspicuous location in the Primary Access Point. Additional copies of Form NRC-3 have been posted at the entrance to the radiation controlled area, at the entrance to the control room, in the General Employee Training facility and in the Administration Building. Although the above five (5) locations are considered sufficient to meet the intent of 10 CFR Parts 19.11(c) and (d) and 50.7(e), additional copies of Form NRC-3 are posted throughout the Waterford 3 site.

Corrective Steps Which Will Be Taken

Form NRC-3 posted at the five (5) locations identified above will be semi-annually examined to ensure that they have not been removed, defaced or altered.

Date When Full Compliance Will Be Achieved

Full compliance was achieved on August 29, 1984.
