NRC presentation concentrated on the essential elements of the new siting rule and its associated changes in 10 CFR Part 50. It was noted that the details of criteria for OBE exceedance, instruments for ground motion recording and post-earthquake plant inspection are included in regulatory guides which in turn endorse appropriate EPRI guidelines with exceptions as necessary.
