Dear Mr. Denton:

During a meeting at your offices on March 25 (Ref. (f)), we discussed the commitments made in support of our request for extension on schedular requirements of 10 CFR 50.49(g) for LaSalle County Station contained in Reference (a). This letter is in response to your request for clarification at that meeting. The following commitments are in addition to those contained within the referenced letters.

Many of the individual components for which extension is requested have delivery dates to the site after the March 31, 1985 deadline. We anticipate receipt of those items beginning in April and continuing through August. We intend to install those items which can be completed during power operation as they become available.

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H. R. Denton - 2 -March 27, 1985 As you recall, we indicated that for LaSalle Unit 2 certain components requiring installation during an outage will not be available at the site until after startup following the current surveillance/EQ modification outage. Unless this work can be accomplished during a subsequent unplanned outage, Commonwealth Edison commits to shut down Unit 2 to complete this work prior to November 30, 1985.
