Gentlemen:

By letter dated March 6, 1984, we acknowledged receipt of your February 15, 1984 response letter to Inspection Reports No. 50-373/83-44 and 50-374/83-48. Our acknowledgement letter stated that since you were appealing the legal basis of some of the items of noncompliance in the subject reports we would not respond to those issues until action was completed on your appeal. It is now our understanding that you have withdrawn your appeal based on a meeting conducted between members of your staff and representatives of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation on March 28, 1984.

Based on the results of the March 28, 1984 meeting and your letter dated June 14, 1984 to Mr. H. R. Denton (NRC) it is our conclusion that the items of non-compliance contained in Inspection Reports No. 50-373/83-44 and 50-374/83-48 do represent valid regulatory and technical issues. The corrective actions described in your February 15, 1984 response to the subject reports in concert with those actions you have undertaken as documented in the aforementioned June 14, 1984 letter are responsive to these issues. We will examine your implementation of these actions during a future inspection.

Your cooperation with us is appreciated.
