^{-&#}x27; The end of discovery means that all responses must be in the hands of the requesting party by May 20, and all depositions must be completed by that date. Therefore, requests for discovery must be made in a time-frame and manner such that answers will be due by May 20. The Board expects that the parties realize that discovery in a finite time-frame is much more efficient when requesters and responders cooperate to their mutual advantage so as to achieve rapid transmission of documents, e.g., by electronic means or by hand delivery.
