Gentlemen:

This letter is a request to renew our License SNM-1498 in accordance with the following support information.

- 1) Institution's name and address: Youngstown Hospital Association, Department of Radiation Oncology, 345 Oak Hill Avenue, Youngstown, Ohio 44501.
- 2) The number of pacemakers to be authorized shall be 10.
- 3) Activities conducted under this license shall be 5 grams (10 individual sources not to exceed 500 milligrams each). The principle reason for renewing the license is to follow patients with implanted pacemakers and to return explanted pacemakers to the manufacturer for proper disposal, but not to implant pacemakers in the future.
- 4) There is no update of the listing of the physicians involved in our plutonium pacemaker program.



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Since we have another NRC license, as I understand it, no fee is required for renewal of this license.


