Dear Sir:

Limiting conditions for operation (LCO) 3.7.9. of the Trojan Technical Specifications require that a special report be provided if certain fire barrier penetrations become nonfunctional and cannot be returned to functional status within seven days.

As a result of routine plant surveillance on March 21, 1984, a three-hour rated door was identified to have been nonfunctional and may have been non-functional for a period longer than seven days. Immediate compensatory action as specified in the LCO was taken upon discovery, which consisted of testing the operability of fire detectors and establishing an hourly fire watch patrol. The fire barrier is being evaluated for corrective action and will be restored to a functional status as soon as possible.
