

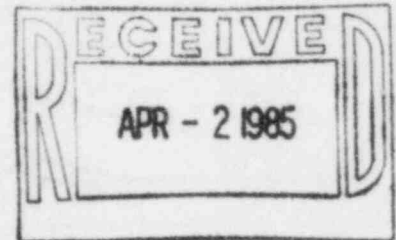

Corrective Steps Which Have Been Taken and Results Achieved

GSU Quality Assurance Engineering performed a followup surveillance of Station 55 and found that the manuals contained the latest revisions of procedures. The ten cited surveillance reports were all responded to and closed by January 14, 1985. Document control verified that there were no other open surveillance reports which had not been responded to within 15 days.

Corrective Steps Which Will Be Taken To Avoid Further Violations

Documented training was provided to the clerks at the document control stations identified in the violation. The training subject was "Control/Maintenance of Site Procedures/Manuals," course number CD 3400.

Document control has issued a memorandum to each controlled document station which requires the responsible party to review the requirements of Construction Site Instruction (CSI) No. 11.1.2, paragraph 5.3.3d, with all clerks at the station. Return acknowledgement of this required action is provided on the lower half of the memorandum.

Date When Full Compliance Was Achieved

Full compliance was achieved by March 12, 1985.




