SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF DECEMBER 13, 1984 MEETING WITH OPPD

AND NRC STAFF REGARDING OPPD'S SECURITY PLAN

Introduction

At the request of the NRC staff, a meeting was held on December 13, 1984 at the NRC offices in Bethesda, Maryland, on the above subject. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss NRC staff concerns relating to the quality of the Fort Calhoun Station Security Plan. The NRC staff concerns arose as a result of recent security inspections, recent security violations, and a security enforcement conference conducted in October 1984. The meeting was chaired by the NRC Project Manager for Fort Calhoun. The agenda for the meeting is contained in Attachment 1. Attachment 2 identifies the meeting attendees.

Summary

The NRC staff presented an overview of the recent security inspections and violations, and an enforcement conference in order to give the meeting attendees a common background in order to discuss the quality of the security plan. OPPD personnel stated that they also have concerns regarding the quality of the plan, and they are currently performing an indepth review. The NRC staff presented 20 concerns relating to the security plan. Each concern was discussed in detail. These concerns were presented as examples. The NRC staff did not perform a recent indepth review of the plan so it is unknown at this time whether the 20 concerns are the only ones affecting the quality of the plan. OPPD personnel acknowledged that the concerns would be considered as examples, and that these concerns would be made a part of their indepth review.

A discussion was also held regarding the interface between the implementation of the plan and the quality of the plan. It was stated that the implementation of the plan is an inspection and enforcement function and the lead rests with the Region. This is why, up to this point, the interface has been primarily between OPPD and the Region. It was also stated that the quality of the plan is a licensing function. This is why the headquarters staff have become involved at this time. The NRC staff stated that they will keep these two areas separate to the extent possible.

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Future Work

The OPPD in-depth review of their security plan should be completed in the first quarter of 1985. OPPD expects to change parts of the security plan, and the changes are expected to increase the plan's effectiveness. This should also occur in the first quarter of 1985. Under the NRC regulations, OPPD will submit a report to Region IV containing a description of each change within two months after the change is made. The changes will be reviewed by Region IV, and it is expected that Region IV will request headquarters assistance in reviewing the changes.
