VOGTLE ELECTRIC GENERATING PLANT RESPONSE TO NRC INSPECTION REPORT 50-424/92-01 AND 50-425/32-01

Georgia Power Company has reviewed the contents of the VEGP Generic Letter 89-10 Inspection Report dated March 4, 1992. The report requested a written response addressing overall program schedule, differential pressure test scope, and the two-stage methodology.

We are in the process of developing a response to each of these items. As you are aware, VEGP began a refueling outage on March 9, 1992. The outage has required extensive support from the personnel responsible for our Generic Letter 89-10 program and has limited access to operations and outage planning personnel. These outage-related constraints have made it difficult to develop an adequate response in the allotted time.

Pursuant to our discussion on May 4, 1992, Georgia Power Company requests an extension until July 10, 1992, for submitting a written response to the VEGP Generic Letter 89-10 Inspection Report. The additional time will allow us to provide a much more definitive response which hopefully will preclude the need for additional information in the future.
