## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of a notification from Southern California Edison Company (SCE) on May 20 and July 8, 1992, a violation of NRC requirements was identified. In accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, the violation is listed below:

10 CFR 55.53(j) prohibits the use of cocaine by individuals licensed under Part 55.

Contrary to the above, the line us d cocaine, as evidenced by a confirmed positive test or that is in this from a unine sample submitted on May 14, 199.

This is a Severity Level III vio ation. (Supplement VII)

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFP 2 201, Jack T. Kroeger is hereby required to submit a written statement of explanation to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, D.C. 20555 with a copy to the Regional Administrator, Region V, and a copy to the NRC Resident Inspector at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station within 30 days of the date of the letter transmitting this Notice of Violation (Notice). This reply should be clearly marked as a "Reply to a Notice of Violation" and should include for each violation: (1) the reason for the violation, or, if contested, the basis for disputing the violation, (2) the corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved, (3) the corrective steps that will be taken to avoid further violations, and (4) the date when full compliance will be achieved. If an adequate reply is not received within the time specified in this Notice, the Commission may issue an order or Demand for Information as to why your license should not be modified, suspended, or revoked, or why such other action as may be proper should not be taken. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending the response time. Under the authority of Section 182 of the Act, 42 U.S.C. 2232, this response shall be submitted under oath or affirmation.


