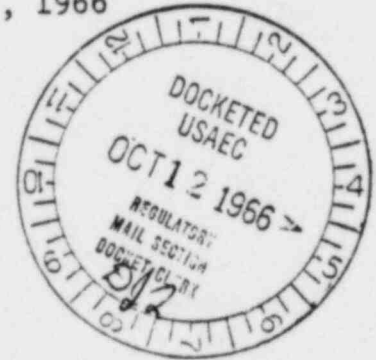


Gentlemen:

The basic purpose of this application is to transfer the activities performed under Source Material License SUB-868 from our Philadelphia plant to our Phoenixville plant. The scope of operations with depleted uranium will stay the same. We will be operating under procedures set up under Byproduct Material License 37-00611-09 recently issued by the Isotopes Branch rather than those in effect presently.
