SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION DATED JUNE 26, 1992

This acknowledges receipt of your letter dated July 20, 1992, in response to our letter dated June 26, 1992, transmitting a Notice of Violation.

In reference to Item No. 4 of the June 26, 1992 Notice of Violation, 10 CFR 35.70(h) requires, in part, that you keep a record of each survey and that the results of contamination surveys shall be expressed in disintegrations per minute (dpm) per 100 square centimeters. If your survey results show no contamination you are still required to record the survey and the results should be recorded in dpm per 100 square centimeters. Therefore, we feel the violation described in Item No. 4 is valid. During a discussion between you and W. P. Reichhold of my staff regarding this violation, it is our understanding that your corrective actions will include keeping a record of all contamination survey results in dpm per 100 square centimeters including those surveys which show no contamination.

Your corrective actions for Items 1, 2, 3, and 5 of the June 26, 1992, Notice of Violation appear adequate and we have no further questions at this time. These corrective actions will be examined during a future inspection.
