This request is made under the federal Freedom of Information act,
5 U.S.C. 552. Please send me copies of:

Process control plan for radioactive waste for Grand Gulf Unit 1.
FSAR sections dealing with radioactive waste disposal for Grand Gulf
Unit 1.

Any changes in the Grand Gulf Unit 1 technical specifications for
its radioactive waste handling and disposal system, and any
documents, letters, memoranda, etc. explaining those changes.

Copies of contracts signed by the owners or operators of Grand Gulf
Unit 1 for waste solidification or disposal by outside contractors.

I understand there are agreements with two such companies.

Copies of process control plan for radioactive waste at Grand Gulf
Unit 1 for those vendors.

All documents, memoranda, letters, etc., concerning modifications of
the radioactive waste handling and disposal system at Grand Gulf,
including the 50.59 review of the modification work.

Copies of any permits for liquid or solid radioactive waste discharges
from Grand Gulf Unit 1. Also any documents, memoranda, letters, etc.,
concerning violations or deviations from those permits.

Copies of original and revised training and qualifications procedures
for radioactive waste operators at Grand Gulf, and any documents,
memoranda, letters, etc., concerning the adequacy of those
procedures.

Copies of an audit by a Nuclear Site QA team which included information
about the nonconformance of training with established procedures.

I originally requested this material from Jim Moore, public affairs
director for Mississippi Power & Light Co., but was told workers at the
plant were too busy to compile the information for me.

As you know, the FOI Act provides that if portions of a document are
exempt from release, the remainder must be segregated and disclosed. There-
fore, I will expect you to send me all nonexempt portions of the records


which I have requested, and ask that you justify any deletions by reference to specific exemptions of the FOI Act. I reserve the right to appeal your decision to withhold any materials.

I am prepared to pay reasonable search and duplication fees in connection with this request. However, the FOI Act provides for waiver or reduction of fees if disclosure could be considered as "primarily benefiting the general public." I intend to use the information I am requesting as the basis for a planned article. Therefore, I ask that you waive all search and duplication fees. If you deny this request, however, please notify me of the charges before you fill my request so I may decide whether to pay the fees or appeal your denial.

As I am making this request in the capacity of a journalist and this information is of timely value, I will appreciate your communicating with me by telephone, rather than by mail, if you have questions.
