Dear Mr. Watkins:

We have received your request for assistance in the review of the Final Site Characterization Report, dated June 15 submitted by Chemetron Corporation. This report was compiled as required by the NRC license termination process.

Cuyahoga County Board of Health received your request August 6, 1492 during the administrative review of our solid waste program. We fully intend to review and comment on the site characterization report, however, the August 15th time frame is inadequate. Due to the depth of the report, the importance of the remediation project, and the annual solid waste survey currently underway, our review will not be completed by the 15th.

CCBH has tracked the progress of this project for a number of years now. From current available information, we can not determine the most environmentally round collution nor can we determine the necessity of a solid vaste facility PTI for what appears to be a remediation project. Use of a PTI style process may be beneficial to collect data to utilize in review of proposed engineering procedures. However, approval or disapproval of such a remediation project based upon issuing a valid PTI would seem to be inappropriate.

Based upon recent letters from the Ohio Department of Health and your agency, we can not ascertain if officials of Ohio are actually in a position to come to and implement a decision which will solve the problem. The difficulty in making this kind of decision seems to be similar to the difficulty Ohio currently is experiencing as a member of the low-level radioactive wasce compact.
