Enclosed you will find a check in the amount of \$500.00. This represents the fine for the purported violation of storing waste containers for longer than our license specifies. Although we do not agree with this penalty, we will pay it so this matter can be put to rest.


As for action we have already taken and future plans to correct our storage conditions, please be informed of the following:

1. We have established an inventory system to keep track not only of the total activity of material on hand but also of the total number of containers in our possession at any given time.
2. We intend to take semi-annual physical inventory, whereby each and every container is inspected for corrosion, tallied and re-stacked or shipped.
3. We intend to vastly reduce our inventory until we have a maximum of two to three trailer loads on hand. This should be accomplished by the end of the year.

We hope this answers the question you had regarding the measures we have taken to correct the problems we have had with storage of waste.
