


Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the document, referenced in Item 9A or 10A, as heretofore changed, remains unchanged and in full force and effect.

The purpose of the modification is to: (1) revise subsection B.3 to incorporate two additional primary Telecommunications Specialists (one Level 1 and one Level 2) to support NRC's planning efforts in relocating to Two White Flint North (TWFN), (2) revise subsection C.4 to incorporate personnel requirements for the two additional telecommunications specialists and expand the personnel requirements for the telecommunications specialist designated as the Project Manager/ Level 1, (3) provide incremental funding in the amount of \$137,023, which fully funds the subject contract, (4) increase the contract ceiling amount by \$78,918 due to an increase in the level of effort, and (5) revise the key personnel clause. Accordingly, the contract is modified as follows:

1. Subsection B.3, schedules nos. 2 and 3 are deleted in their entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

2. Subsection B.5 entitled "CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION--DELIVERY ORDERS (JUNE 1988)," the contract ceiling amount is increased by \$78,918 from \$283,023 to \$361,941. Therefore, the first sentence of paragraph a. is revised to read as follows:

"a. The total estimated amount of this contract (ceiling) for the products/services ordered, delivered, and accepted under this contract is \$361,941."

In addition, the contract obligated amount is increased by \$215,941 from \$146,000 to \$361,941. Therefore, the first sentence of paragraph b. is revised to read as follows:

"b. The amount presently obligated with respect to this contract is \$361,941."

3. Subsection C.4 entitled Personnel Requirements is deleted in its entirety and the attached requirements are substituted in lieu thereof.
4. Article H.1 entitled "Key Personnel" is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

C.4 Personnel Requirements

C.4.1 The contractor shall provide a minimum of four Telecommunications Specialists (two Level 1 and two Level 2) who will be located at the NRC provided office space. Backup Telecommunications Specialists shall be provided in accordance with paragraphs B.4 and C.3.3 herein. The Telecommunications Specialists shall be available during the core hours of 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, and after the core hours on an as needed basis.

C.4.2 All telecommunications personnel performing the requirements of this specification shall be U.S. citizens.

C.4.3 One Level 1 Telecommunications Specialist shall be designated as the Contractor's Project Manager with total responsibility for all duties and operations listed in Section C.3 and in addition, manage TWFN relocation efforts, manage the ongoing telecommunications account records review, direct on-site supervision of contractor personnel and coordinate all activities with the NRC Project Manager. The Contractor's Project Manager shall have a minimum of six years experience in the voice/data telecommunications field in addition to:

C.4.3.1 A minimum of one year experience as a Project Manager (Government Contract support as Project Manager is desirable).

C.4.3.2 A working knowledge of Dbase III, Lotus 1-2-3, Wordperfect 5.0, Electronic Key systems and data communications, i.e. Local Area Networks (LAN), Wide Area Networks (WAN) and mainframe to mainframe/terminal communications.

C.4.3.3 A good working knowledge of WITS.

C.4.3.4 Good personal communications skills, both written and oral.

C.4.3.5 Experience and ability to perform cost analysis of telecommunications systems and equipment.

C.4.3.6 Three years experience in the development, processing and review of work orders, key sheets and floor plans.

C.4.3.7 Two years experience in the operation and maintenance of Private Branch Exchange (PBX) systems.

C.4.4 One Level 1 Telecommunications Specialist shall be designated as the TWFN Relocation Coordinator and shall perform duties as listed in section C.3, where applicable, with additional responsibility over TWFN relocation efforts, coordinating all activities with the Level 1 Telecommunications Specialist/Project Manager and the NRC Telecommunications Branch TWFN Move Coordinator. The TWFN Relocation Coordinator shall have a minimum of five years experience in the voice/data telecommunications field in addition to:

C.4.4.1 Experience in organizing office relocation efforts to include planning, acquisition of new telecommunications systems and equipment and coordination with other NRC designated relocation teams.

C.4.4.2 A working knowledge of Dbase III, Lotus 1-2-3, Wordperfect 5.0, Electronic Key systems and data communications, i.e Local Area Networks (LAN), Wide Area Networks (WAN) and mainframe to mainframe/terminal.

C.4.4.3 A good working knowledge of WITS.

C.4.4.4 Good personal communications skills, both written and oral.

C.4.4.5 Experience and ability to perform cost analysis of telecommunications systems and equipment.

C.4.4.6 Three years experience in the development, processing and review of work orders, key sheets and floor plans.

C.4.4.7 Two years experience in the operation and maintenance of Private Branch Exchange (PBX) systems.

C.4.5 One Level Two Telecommunications Specialist shall perform duties as listed in section C.3 where applicable, coordinating all activities with the Contractor's Project Manager and the NRC Project Manager. This Telecommunications Specialist shall have a minimum of four years experience in the voice/data telecommunications field in addition to:

C.4.5.1 A working knowledge of Dbase III, Lotus 1-2-3, Wordperfect 5.0, Electronic Key systems and data communications, i.e Local Area Networks (LAN), Wide Area Networks (WAN) and mainframe to mainframe/terminal.

C.4.5.2 A good working knowledge of WITS.

C.4.5.3 Good personal communications skills, both written and oral.

C.4.5.4 Experience and ability to perform cost analysis of telecommunications systems and equipment.

C.4.5.5 Two years experience in the development, processing and review of work orders, key sheets and floor plans.

C.4.5.6 Two years experience in the operation and maintenance of Private Branch Exchange (PBX) systems.
