Dear U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission,

Per the May 7, 1996 routine safety inspection conducted by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I and the subsequent Notice of Violation issued to Shenango Incorporated, the following is in response for failure to comply with License Condition 11.B of NRC License No. 37-20505-01.

Please be advised that the referenced violation was incurred when the Shenango's former Plant Manager/Radiation Safety Officer resigned. The newly appointed plant manager was unaware that assuming the position of Radiation Control Officer entailed successful completion of a 40-hour Radiation Safety Officer training course. As such, Shenango's present Plant Manager/Radiation Safety Officer had not successfully completed the required training program at the time of the May 7, 1996 inspection.

Shenango has taken immediate compliance action by having the Radiation Safety Officer attend and successfully complete the required training course and would like the Commission to recognize the effort. A photocopy of the awarded certificate is attached for your review.

Shenango will also file a revised application for material license with Region I of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission that will list the current certified individual as the Radiation Safety Officer.
