- Please delete Authorized Medical Physicist Kyle Verdecchia, Ph.D., he has left our facility. Take your time with this if it delays my second request below.
- My second amendment request is a request to expedite, I specifically need this amendment completed by the date of May 11, 2020. The reason for this expedited request is there is a newer 1, 2 or 3 day dosing available for Sirtex, and our Sirtex Authorized User Dr. Jain wants us to change our item 8K possession limits to now say 296mCi per vial, 3 Curies total. This amendment will allow us to use the more concentrated 3 day dose, for smaller tumors. We do not want a per vial limit. Just this specific Y-90 portion I would like expedited, as Dr. Jain is currently consulting with a patient and hopes to treat within the next 2-3weeks at the most for this 3day dose, and this is the best chance for this patient according to Dr. Jain.
