RE: NOTICE OF RECIPROCAL RECOGNITION OF LICENSE FOR USE IN UTAH
NRC Radioactive Material License Number 42-01068-07, Amendment 86
Well Logging

Dear Mr. Hernandez:

In accordance with Halliburton Energy Services, Inc.'s request dated March 23, 2020 and R313-19-30 of the Utah Administrative Code, the licensee is hereby authorized to use radioactive materials at the temporary job sites you have specified, provided the job sites are not in areas under exclusive Federal jurisdiction. The use of radioactive materials must be conducted in accordance with the representations in Halliburton Energy Services, Inc.'s letter, Utah and Radiation Control Rules and Halliburton Energy Services, Inc.'s NRC radioactive material license. At least three days written notification is required before engaging in any licensed activity within the State of Utah. Permission may be granted by the Director to proceed sooner in the case of undue hardship.

The Licensee should notify this office in a timely manner of a change in the information provided in the initial reciprocity request. This authorization is not effective after December 31, 2020 or 180 possession days in a calendar year, whichever occurs earlier.
