This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. A. Dunlop of this office on September 28 through October 2, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities for your Fermi 2 facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

The areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. These areas consisted primarily of a review of the Fermi 2 program for the activities regarding the performance of check valves. Within this area, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.
