SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 030-32598/92-01

This refers to the initial, announced inspection conducted by Messrs. Mark R. Shaffer and Gilbert L. Guerra of this office on October 19, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized by Byproduct Material License No. 42-27424-01. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with members of your staff.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under the license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of the license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews of personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

During this initial inspection, the inspectors discussed with your staff the requirements with which you must comply, including the NRC and Department of Transportation regulations, and the commitments in your license application. The NRC enforcement policy was also discussed at this time.

No violations or deviations were identified; therefore, no response to this letter is required.

The inspectors observed that the licensee possessed a single bone mineral analyzer containing iodine-125 as a sealed source. Licensed activities were performed by three individuals under the supervision of one authorized user. The device was stored at the licensee's facility in Denton, Texas, and was transported in the licensee's private vehicle to a temporary jobsite in Bethany, Oklahoma. Records of licensed activities were adequate for the size and scope of the radiation safety program.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
