SUBJECT: GE NUCLEAR ENERGY ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGE

Gentlemen:

In Licensing Topical Report NEDO-11209-04A, Revision 8, GE Nuclear Energy committed to notify the Nuclear Regulatory Commission of organizational changes affecting the GE Nuclear Quality Assurance Program within thirty days of implementation. In compliance with that commitment, notification of organizational changes within GE Nuclear Energy is transmitted herein.

These organizational changes are directed to our changing business needs and do not degrade the GE Nuclear Energy quality system or impact commitments contained in our Licensing Topical Report NEDO-11209-04A, Revision 8. All quality functions and their associated organizational independence per Criteria 1 of 10CFR50, Appendix B, have been retained.

The following summarizes organizational changes effective October 8, 1992:

The Nuclear Services and Projects Department (NS&PD) has been reorganized as follows:

- The former Projects, Configuration Management Services, Field Services Territory, and Engineering Services organizations have been restructured into Technical Services, Modification Services and Engineering organizations.
- Plant Monitoring Systems and Services organizations formally reported to another GE Division and now is part of NS&PD.
- All of quality functions in NS&PD have been centralized in the new Quality Assurance organization, which replaces the former Product Quality Assurance organization and continues as direct report to the NS&PD General Manager.

The Irradiation Processing Operation now report directly to the Vice President and General Manager, GE Nuclear Energy. This organization formerly reported to the BWR Technology organization. The quality function for this organization is part of the Regulatory Compliance group.

There are additional minor name changes in a few other organizations but these organizations were not reorganized and their functions remain the same.

The attached organization chart illustrates these changes.

These organizational changes will be addressed in the next revision of Licensing Topical Report NEDO-11209-04A.
