Dear Ms. Lampert:

I am responding to your letter of September 29, 1992 to Secretary Chilk, in which you requested comments on the issue of protective clothing and breathing apparatus for the Harbormaster and his staff.

The Pilgrim task force reported that Duxbury ad referred this issue to the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH). The task force concluded that MDPH should resolve this issue, as documented in NUREG-1438, ":indings on Issues of Offsite Emergency Preparedness for Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station." We understand that Mr. Robert Hallisey, Director of the Radiation Control Program. MDPH, discussed this matter in a letter of March 13, 1991, to the town. Nevertheless, you also asked us several related questions which we have answered in the enclosure to this letter.

As you know, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) is responsible for reviewing and approving State and local emergency plans and preparedness for coping with radiological emergencies at licensed nuclear power plants. Accordingly we are also sending a copy of your letter to FEMA for their consideration.
