Gentlemen:

In previous submittals to the NRC, Dairyland Power Cooperative has made various commitments in matters related to compliance with the requirements of Appendix R to 10 CFR 50. One of these was re-routing and protecting cables and installing disable switches for the Manual Depressurization System. The location of these switches was originally planned for the Electrical Penetration Room. Subsequently, an alternate location inside the Containment Building Personnel Airlock, was proposed, discussed, and selected. The reasons for selecting the new location were:

- 1) It is on the route taken by the operator(s) when the remote shutdown procedure is used.
- 2) The switches would then be located outside of the fire areas of concern; Control Room, Electrical Equipment Room, Machine Shop, and Electrical Penetration Room. (The Personnel Airlock is part of the Containment Building fire area.)
- 3) The MDS cables would not, then, be required to be re-routed and/or protected with one hour fire wrap outside of the Containment Building.
