I am responding to your letters of July 25, 1996 concerning my public meeting to be held in Waterford, Connecticut, on August 6 from 3:00 - 4:00 p.m.

I agree that written questions may be submitted up to the time of and during the meeting. Interested persons should be encouraged to submit questions to First Selectman Sheridan as soon as practicable.

I do recognize that there are citizens who would prefer an evening meeting. I also believe you can appreciate the difficulties involved in scheduling the visit consistent with my other duties and commitments for that time frame. On August 6, I will visit all three Millstone units and meet with Northeast Utilities management. I will also meet with the press and be available to respond to their questions prior to attending the meeting with the general public. Due to the demands of this schedule and other commitments, scheduling an evening public meeting is not practical.

If it appears during the public meeting that additional time is needed in order to address questions posed by the public, I will extend the time for the meeting to the extent my schedule permits.
