

Dear Mr. Shear:

In response to your letter dated September 30, 1992, we are responding to your request for description of proposed corrective action for Violation #1.

Since the inspection conducted by Mr. Michael F. Webber of your office on September 17, 1992, we have appointed the assistant laboratory manager as the person responsible for the leak tests of the Troxler nuclear gauges. We have prepared a schedule stating the frequency of testing, which is every six months, and we will leak test all of our Troxlers a' the same time. A notice was placed on the Troxler storage room door stating the date in which Troxiers are to be leak tested. After the testing, another notice will be posted with the next leak test date. As the radiation safety officer, I will see to it that these procedures are followed.
