SUBJECT: NOTICE OF DEVIATION

(NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 70-1201/92-06)

This refers to the inspection conducted by E. B. Pharr of this office on September 21-25, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Commercial Nuclear Fuel Plant. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

The inspection did not reveal violations of NRC requirements. However, certain activities having safety significance appeared to deviate from commitments to the NRC. The deviation and elements to be included in your response are described in the enclosed Notice of Deviation. We are concerned about the deviation because the failure to adequately complete corrective ctions to previous violations appears to indicate a continued lack of attention to Radiation Protection program details. Accurate procedures are necessary to ensure guidance is available for proper program implementation. In addition, the enclosed Inspection Report identifies activities that violated NRC requirements that will not be subject to enforcement action because the licensee's efforts in correcting the violation meet the criteria specified in Section V.G. of the Enforcement Policy.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.

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In accordance with 10 CFR 2.750 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure(s) will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

The responses directed by this letter and the enclosed Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, Pub. L. No. 96-511.
