SUBJECT: Amendments to NRC export licenses to EURATOM

TO: Ms. Betty Wright, Nuclear Regulatory Commission

In response to requests to amend the export licenses listed below, which involve material of Australian and Canadian origin, the Office of Arms Control and Nonproliferation has received prior consent for exports of Australian origin and Canadian origin material to EURATOM. The Agreement between Australia and the United States of America concerning Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy allows such exports for conversion, enrichment up to 20% U-235, fuel fabrication, use in a reactor, storage or final disposal other than reprocessing. The Agreement for Cooperation Concerning Civil Uses of Atomic Energy between Canada and the United States allows exports to EURATOM of natural uranium, depleted uranium, other source material, uranium enriched to less than 20% in the isotope U-235, and heavy water.
