CANCELLATION OF REQUEST FOR RULEMAKING

The purpose of this memorandum is to request that the Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research terminate its efforts, requested in my July 12, 1995, memorandum to you, to ravise financial assurance requirements for uranium recovery licensees. The requested rulemaking was intended to address two perceived deficiencies in Criterion 9 of Appendix A to 10 CFR Part 40. The rulemaking would have revised Criterion 9 to: 1) allow the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to obtain financial assurance for proposed revisions to reclamation plans prior to NRC approval of the revision; and 2) require that a standby trust be incorporated into licensee financial sureties.

By memorandum to you dated June 7, 1996, Stuart A. Treby stated that in the opinion of the Office of the General Counsel (OGC), Criterion 9 allows the staff to require increased financial surety from a licensee at the time a revised reclamation plan is submitted. OGC therefore did not support the first part of the rulemaking.

Although we continue to support the second part of the proposed rulemaking, to require standby trusts, we conclude that a separate rulemaking to correct this deficiency is not warranted in terms of the effort it would entail.

We are in the early stages of preparing a user need memorandum requesting a comprehensive revision to the uranium recovery aspects of Part 40 and will include the standby trust requirement in that request.
