Enclosed please find our application for a By-Product Material License. We are seeking licensure in order to conduct the following activities:

- Manufacture and distribution of Gold-198 seeds for medical implants in cancer therapy, to persons authorized to possess material pursuant to 10 CFR 35, or Agreement State licenses;
- 2. Calibration of survey meters:
- Conduct training classes in the safe handling of radioactive materials;
- 4. Perform miscellaneous consultive activities involving radioactive materials and radiation safety, i.e., leak testing, maintenance, monitoring, relocation, and/or removal of industrial gauges containing radioactive material. Included would also be decontamination and monitoring during emergency situations.

Our training classes would typically be 1-12 days in length, but could be expanded to go into greater detail, depending on the customer's individual needs.

All individuals who will use byproduct material at our facility will be required to demonstrate a proficiency and knowledge concerning the proper handling and hazards involved. If they have not previously received training, they will be required to read the Standard Operating Procedures and the training manual, attend a class, and pass a written examination before handling any licensed material. Records of employee qualifications will be maintained for review.
