This is to confirm the conversation I had with you on February 18th and with John Sinclair on February 19. 1982.

It is my understanding that Robert Warnick, Region III Investigative Branch Chief, has confirmed our belief that there has been no formal referral to the Justice Department for prosecution. Rather, I & E is continuing its investigation and still has several areas it is pursuing, including: the qualifications of some inspectors; equipment (sizemic hangars, cable trays); the procedures for design document changes; and the systems turnover program. It is also my understanding that I & E wishes to conduct additional interviews.

I greatly appreciate your obtaining this confirmation so promptly. Please advise this office immediately of any change in status.


