He further stated that the Board would not deny the State of Oklahoma's Motion For Extension of Time even though he believed that a Motion To Participate As An Interested State had not been filed.
- 3. That I informed Jeannine Hale of my conversation with Bob Pierce and she agreed that September 20, 1996 would be an appropriate date for comment
- 4. That on the afternoon of August 15, 1996, I received another call from Bob Pierce changing the initial deadline for comment to September 6, 1996.

- 6. That on August 19, 1996, I received the Memorandum & Order on the Motion and could not determine the deadline for comment. I then contacted Bob Pierce who then informed me that the State of Oklahoma was not granted time for comment because a Motion To Participate As An Interested State had not been filed.
- 7. That because the State of Oklahoma was informed that the Motion would not be required to comment, the State did not request admission as an interested state prior to the Memorandum & Order of August 19, 1996.
- 8. That Jeannine Hale could not be informed of the Board's decision until August 20, 1996.
