Licensee Completion of Annual Operating Test

In the letter of January 16, 1996,¹ Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) notified the Staff that Mr. Richard A. Cox, License No. OP-10670-1, Docket No. 55-61040, had not completed the 1995 Annual Operating Test in accordance with the Licensed Operator Regualification Program. The program requirements were not completed due to corrective surgery that Mr. Cox underwent in the last quarter of 1995.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Mr. Cox successfully completed the 1995 Annual Operating Test on June 25, 1996, and is currently enrolled in the 1996 Licensed Operator Regualification Training Program. In addition, the current NRC Form 396 for Mr. Cox has been reviewed and determined to be correct.

After successfully completing the 1995 Annual Operating Test, Mr. Cox was returned to licensed duties on the week of July 7, 1996.


