Dear Ms. Stephens:

This is in response to your letter and accompanying petition dated June 20, 1984, to Ms. Jona Souder, Chief of the NRC's Local Public Document Room Branch requesting the relocation of the Wolf Creek local public document room (LPDR) from the William Allen White Library in Emporia, Kansas to the Washburn Law Library in Topeka, Kansas. This will also confirm our telephone conversation of last week.

After careful consideration, the NRC has decided to establish an additional LPDR for the Wolf Creek plant at the Washburn Law Library in Topeka. During the next few weeks the NRC will be forwarding to the Washburn Law Library copies of all NRC publicly available Wolf Creek records on microfiche for the period from April 1979 to 1984. Beginning in 1984 and continuing into the future, we will also send paper copy of all available records on Wolf Creek. In addition, the NRC will send to the Washburn Law Library chronological accession lists and cumulative accession lists of the records contained in the files.

As I mentioned on the telephone, we have discussed the above plans with the staff of the Governor's Office and the staff of the State Corporation Commission, and these arrangements are acceptable to them.


