SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM

The United States of America to:

Harold L. Price, Director of Regulation, United States Atomic
Energy Commission or such representative as he may appoint.

You are hereby commanded to appear at the hearing to be held
in Courtroom 4 on the seventh floor of the United States Federal Court-
house, 316 North Roberts Street, St. Paul, Minnesota, on the 28th day
of April, 1970, at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon, said hearing pertaining
to the proposed issuance to Northern States Power Company of a pro-
visional operating license for its Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant,
Unit 1, and to bring with you to produce as evidence at said hearing
the original reports, or complete copies thereof, of the inspections made
by the Division of Compliance, United States Atomic Energy Commission,
in connection with the construction of the subject nuclear generating plant,
and related quality control and assurance programs. Such reports

are to include reports of inspections listed at Appendix A, Supplement No. 1, to the AEC Regulatory Staff Safety Evaluation.


Section 2.720(f) of the Commission's Rules of Practice provides as follows:

"(f) On motion made promptly, and in any event at or before the time specified in the subpoena for compliance by the person to whom the subpoena is directed, and on notice to the party at whose instance the subpoena was issued, the presiding officer, or if he is unavailable, the Commission may (1) quash or modify the subpoena if it is unreasonable or requires evidence not relevant to any matter in issue, or (2) condition denial of the motion on just and reasonable terms."
