SUBJECT: HEALTH PHYSICS PROGRAM AT TMI

A consultant to Metropolitan Edison, NUS, concluded that there were areas of TMI's health physics program which were unacceptable. I understand the staff has met with Med Ed on this subject and identified its concerns in a letter to which Met Ed has responded. I would like a copy of the minutes of this meeting and any correspondence relating to this problem as soon as possible.

I would like by September 5, 1979 a status report of Met Ed's current weaknesses in this area and the specific plans with timetables which the staff believe are necessary to remedy any of the deficiencies. Additionally, the Commission should be kept currently informed of developments in the nealth physics area.
