Dear Sir:

The Fourth District Executive Committee which met on February 26, 1968 passed unanimously this resolution.

WHEREAS Northern States Power Company has demonstrated a continual lack of concern for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the city and of this state, and

WHEREAS Northern States Power has ruined places of beauty, polluted the air we breathe, and now is planning to further pollute the water we drink with radioactivity from the new Monticello plant,

BE IT RESOLVED that Northern States Power be severely censured for its total lack of concern for our health and well being.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that communication be sent to the entire Minnesota Congressional delegation informing them of our fear of the results of radioactive pollution in the form of leukemia and birth defects along with our request that Northern States Power be stopped from allowing any radioactive waste matters from in any manner getting into the Mississippi River and into our water supply.

I have been instructed to inform you of this resolution and ask for your help.
