

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.54 (p), Georgia Power Company hereby submits Revision 9 to the Vogtle Electric Generating Plant Nuclear Security Training and Qualification Plan (VEGP TQP). Each modification of the TQP in Revision 9 is marked with a revision bar and deletes a training requirement "to react to direct fire weapons," i.e., paintguns. The deletion of this training element does not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of nuclear security. Vogtle Electric Generating Plant continues to meet the regulatory requirements for security personnel as seen in 10 CFR 73, Appendix B.
