Subject: Toledo Edison Preliminary Response to "Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station - Staff Review of Generic Letter 90-06, "Resolution of Generic Issue 70, Power-Operated Relief Valve and Block Valve Reliability', and Generic Issue 94, 'Additional Low-Temperature Overpressure Protection for Light-Water Reactors, Pursuant to 10CFR50.54(f)", Dated October 14, 1992.

Gentlemen:

By letters dated December 21, 1990 (Toledo Edison letter Serial Number 1884) and June 26, 1992 (Toledo Edison letter Serial Number 2046), Toledo Edison responded to Generic Letter 90-06. The NRC staff reviewed those responses and provided comments in their letter dated October 14, 1992 (Log Number 3850) regarding the incorporation of model Technical Specifications (including the testing of the power-operated relief valve (PORV)). Toledo Edison has subsequently discussed these comments with Hr. J. B. Hopkins, Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station (DBNPS) NRC Senior Project Manager, and informed him of a babcock and Wilcox Owners Group (B&WOG) initiative to address these comments.

In addition to Toledo Edison (DBNPS), all Babcock and Wilcox Owners Group (B&WOG) utilities with operating plants responded to Generic Letter 90-06. The NRC letters addressing these responses have also been received by General Public Utilities Nuclear (Three Mile Island-1) and Entergy (Arkansas Nuclear One-1). The remaining B&WOG units expect to receive similar letters. Since the application of model Technical Specifications is a generic issue, a B&WOG response is being formulated with Toledo Edison participation. A conference telephone call between the B&WOG utilities and the NRC staff is scheduled for December 17, 1992 to discuss these matters. Accordingly, Toledo Edison's response to the NRC's comments of October 14, 1992 will be held in abeyance until atter the discussion between the B&WOG utilities and the NRC staff has taken place. Based on this conference call, Toledo Edison will then inform the DBNPS NRC Senior Project Manager of its schedule for responding to the NRC's comments.
