To conclude the action items identified in Generic Letter 83-28, "Required Actions Based on Generic Implications of Salem ATWS Events, "Houston Lighting & Power Company (HL&P) has completed development of the Master Parts List (MPL). This list has been under development to provide more detail in support of identification of safety-related equipment, components, and parts in response to Action Item 2.2.1. A description of the MPL and the schedule for development was submitted in References 1 and 2.

Development of the Master Parts List required evaluation of approximately 100,000 tagged permanent plant components. Each application of equipment on a component level was reviewed to ensure proper identification of safety-related components. In addition, lists of parts or subcomponents were developed when appropriate. These lists assist in identification of safety-related parts within safety-related components and aid in routine maintenance and procurement activities. HL&P intends to continue updating the Master Parts List as needed.

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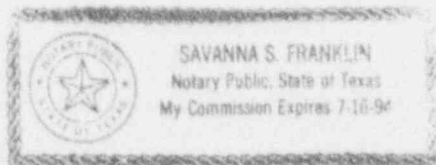
