At 9:00a.m. on February 8, 1980, the licensee informed the Resident Inspector of an industrial accident which occurred in the Unit 2 Torus and involved a contractor who severed two of his fingers. The contractor was immediately rushed to the hospital. An initial survey for contamination was accomplished and no gross contamination was detected, however, licensee radiation protection personnel accompanied the contractor to the hospital to further determine if any contamination is present. Contamination is not expected to be significant because of the relatively low levels of contamination in the area of the Torus.

Neither the licensee nor RIII plan to make a press release.
