Subject: RESUMPTION OF CONSTRUCTION AT BRAIDWOOD

Braidwood Station will be starting limited construction of safety related activities next week. This is the result of a recent rate increase they were allowed. Present staff is 100 people. They plan to slowly increase staff to a high of about 700 to be reached in June. There were 1,750 construction workers on site prior to their shutdown in September 1979.
